ACADEMIC ACHEIVEMENTS

Let me start with the academic achievement of the school. We are happy to share the details of the commendable performances of our students of Classes X and XII.

I am elated to inform you that Class XII result was amazingly excellent with 100% output. In class XII Science stream, the highest mark was 478 out of 500 i.e. 96% secured by Ms. Amirthavarshini and 50% of our students scored

above 400. Coming to class X result, the school produced 2 centum in Tamil and two centum in Mathematics. Special congratulations to Arshitha and Shivani C for achieving centum in Tamil, and Arshitha and Jivan for securing centum in Maths.

Shrushti Dakshinamoorthy is the class X topper by scoring 482 i.e. 96.4% marks and 35% of students scored above 450 and 71% of students scored above 400. I congratulate all the students, their parents and the teachers for their effort to achieve this success. All of them deserve a big round of applause.

Excellence in Innovation:

Our school encourages students to be leading innovators by conducting science exhibitions, providing mandatory ATL periods from classes I to IX. Our school innovation teams are using the ATL lab facility to take up new challenges and bring laurel to the school.

- A team of six students, SAM V, Mathew, Varshith, Sharveshan, Krishovine, Srikrishna, and Amish Mohan, participated in the national level SEED—entrepreneurship program. Organized and sponsored by ATL, Niti Ayog, Govt of India and Dassult System. They presented their project - A 3D designed software printed model “TE COOL”; an eco-friendly air cooler, at Coimbatore, Bangalore and Pune at district, state and National level respectively. Our’s was the only school from Tamil Nadu to reach up to the national level and won the BEST ATL SCHOOL award. In recognition of this innovative project our school received an invitation to participate in the 3rd anniversary celebration of the National Education Policy (NEP) in Delhi. The event witnessed the felicitation of students by Honourable Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi. This

recognition at a national level is a testament of the innovation, creativity and hard work of our students and teachers.

- Our students Sam V Mathew, Iniyaa, and Gokulamahesarajan participated in Jigyasa Aero Fest, a 3-day national level competition held at Bengaluru and presented their innovative ideas, model and a report about “Electric Aircraft”. Our team was one among the top 10 teams in India. It was an immense learning experience for the students.

- 15 students from our school have published their books under the CBSE Budding Author’s Program. Master. Joshua Jeba Kumar’s book “A Space Voyage” has been selected for a special award by the Trichy District Library. NEW INITIATIVES

I would like to share some exciting developments and new initiatives that have unfolded at CARE International School over the past year. These initiatives are aimed at creating an enriched and nurturing environment for our students.

- This year, we have taken a significant step by recruiting in-house staffs for JEE/NEET preparations, from Andhra Pradesh. Recognizing the

- we are delighted to announce the renovation of our Indoor Basketball Stadium, Badminton, and Throw Ball Courts. These facilities are designed to provide a conducive environment for our budding athletes to excel in their respective sports.
- Understanding the importance of mental health in a student's overall well-being, we conducted a counseling session for students of Grade VII – XI. This session aimed to address the emotional and psychological needs of our students, promoting a supportive environment within the school.
- As a part of Experiential learning, Grade VI – VIII students went on a three-day trip to Trivandrum, while Grade IX – XII students explored

Wayanad. These trips provided unique opportunities for hands-on learning, cultural immersion, and team building.
